Location: Situated in the serene and secluded Queen's Canyon, guests feel miles away though are actually just minutes from the world-renowned Garden of the Gods, historic downtown Colorado Springs, and shopping in Old Colorado City. The Colorado Springs Municipal Airport is only 30 minutes away and Denver is an easy, one-hour drive north.

Guests can spend the night in the historic castle, built for General Palmer's wife Queen, the historic Pink House or our more recently renovated lodges. Glen Eyrie is a unique property secluded in Queen's Canyon and is frequented by a variety of Colorado wildlife.


Glen Eyrie has meeting spaces and accommodations as unique as your group
